Lexema Ltd has consolidated experience in the operational management of international mobility activities, particularly in relation to **Erasmus+ learning mobility projects**. The organisation has developed its experience through cooperation with sending institutions and project partners, mainly as a hosting/intermediary partner in Malta, supporting the preparation, implementation and monitoring of mobility activities for learners, educators and staff.

The organisation's relevant activities include the coordination of work-based learning placements (internships), job shadowing programmes, staff training activities, educational visits and group mobility support.

Lexema also provides the related local services required for implementation, such as accommodation and logistics coordination, language and cultural support, mentoring, participant monitoring, communication with sending organisations, and support with project documentation and follow-up procedures.

A key area of Lexema's experience is the matching of participants' profiles and learning objectives with suitable host environments through cooperation with local companies, trainers and stakeholders across different sectors.

This contributes to the quality and coherence of the mobility experience and supports the development of professional competences, transversal skills and intercultural awareness within a structured European learning context.

What are the skills and expertise of key staff/ persons involved in this application?


